Dental implants are marketed as a "permanent" solution, and while they are designed to last a lifetime, this isn't guaranteed and certainly not without proper oral care. Regular brushing, flossing, and professional cleanings are still essential to maintain the health of your gums and prevent issues like peri-implantitis (inflammation around the implant). Secret #5: Recovery Takes Time - More Than You May Think

While some dental clinics advertise "same-day implants," the truth is that full recovery can take months. After the implant is placed, it takes time for the bone to fuse to the titanium post in a process called osseointegration – this usually takes 3 months but in some cases may take longer. Rushing this process can lead to complications. At Middleton St George Dental Care, we prioritize healing and comfort, maximising the chances that the implant has integrated before proceeding with any restorations. We do carry out "same day teeth" cases where the implants and teeth are placed in the same visit, but these require a lot of time planning to make sure that the chances of success are optimised.

Secret #6: The Process Involves More Than Just the Implant

When you think of dental implants, you might picture the replacement tooth—but the process involves multiple components. The implant itself is a titanium post that's surgically placed in your jawbone. Once healed, for a single tooth a custom-made ceramic crown is made to complete the process. Multiple implants can also be placed to support rows of fixed teeth (bridges) or to dramatically improve the stability of dentures. Each of these stages requires expert care, which is why we manage every step in-house for continuity and precision.

Secret #7: You May Need a Temporary Prosthesis

During the healing phase, especially for front teeth, you may need a temporary prosthesis (a removable denture or temporary bridge) to fill the gap until your final implant is ready. This can be an important part of the process to maintain your smile's aesthetics and functionality. We will always ensure you are informed about all of the available options.

Secret #8: Some Implants Require Bone Grafting

Not everyone has sufficient bone density to support an implant. In cases where bone loss has occurred due to infection, injury, or gum disease, a bone graft may be necessary to rebuild the jawbone. While this adds time and cost to the procedure, it's essential for long-term success. At Middleton St George Dental Care, we perform bone grafts with cutting-edge microsurgery techniques to ensure you have a strong, healthy foundation for your implant.

Secret #9: Dental Implants Can Prevent Further Bone Loss

One of the key benefits of dental implants that is often overlooked is their ability to prevent further bone loss in your jaw. When a tooth is missing, the jawbone begins to deteriorate over time because there's no root to stimulate bone growth. An implant acts like a tooth root, helping to stimulate the bone and preserve your bone structure reducing changes to your facial appearance.
